Legendary band to play on the National Stadium

Established in 1981 in Los Angeles by drummer Lars Ulrich and guitarist and singer James Hetfield, Metallica became one of the most important and influential bands in the history of rock. The American group has so far published 11 albums, sold 110 million records and won many prestigious awards, including Grammy, American Music Awards, Billboard Awards and MTV Video Music Awards. In 2009 Metallica joined the elite Rock and Roll Hall of Fame.

The Warsaw concert will be a part of Sonisphere Festival 2014. Interestingly enough, Metallica will play the pieces, which will be selected by Polish fans – buyers of tickets online, replying to a special questionnaire on Metallica's website.

For the first time solo in Poland

Justin Timberlake, whose music from the albums *The 20/20 Experience* and *The 20/20 Experience* – 2 of 2 dominated the charts in 2013, will be back in Poland after 17 years. This time not as a member of 'N Sync, but as a solo artist, he will appear before fans at a concert at the stadium in Gdańsk.

Timberlake began his career in the *Mickey Mouse Club* show, where he appeared together with Britney Spears and Cristina Aguilera among others. There he also met JC Chasez, with whom he created 'N Sync. After six years of working with the band he decided to pursue a solo career. In 2002 he released his first album *Justified* and his *Cry Me a River* and *Like I Love You* appeared on music charts. All in all Justin Timberlake has already released three studio albums.
