

# REPORT 2025



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Dear Sir and Madam,

The year 2025 was a special time for the Bank Millennium Foundation, as we celebrated the 35th anniversary of our activity. For over three decades, we have been continuously pursuing the mission of supporting local communities, building civic attitudes and developing social sensitivity. Our activities are invariably focused on three pillars: financial education, employee volunteering and support for culture. Our achievements deserve to be emphasized: In its own Financial ABCs programme, the Foundation has trained almost 100 thousand children, every year it engages over 200 volunteers-employees who carry out their own initiatives, and has also supported many cultural initiatives.

**In 2025, the Foundation established cooperation with Zachęta - the National Gallery of Art**, one of the most important cultural institutions in Poland, in order to promote the accessibility of art and strengthen its role in shaping social sensitivity.

In the area of employee volunteering, we initiated a grant project that enabled Bank Millennium Group employees to be more independent in creating and implementing initiatives responding to local needs. **In 2025, thanks to the commitment and energy of over 300 volunteers, 54 different initiatives were created, bringing meaningful support to communities throughout Poland.**

Financial education of preschool children has invariably remained an important direction of our activities. Financial ABCs have been appreciated by teachers and parents for years. **In 2025, 400 workshops were carried out, in which over 9500 children participated.** The programme is under the patronage of the Ombudsman for Children. What is more, in 2025 measures have been taken towards the full availability of the Financial ABCs programme. This is an extremely important stage in the development of the programme for us – a step towards full inclusiveness and equal access to knowledge. We encourage you to read the full report, where you will find details of all activities undertaken by the Foundation in 2025.

The Bank Millennium Foundation was established on 10th December 1990. For 35 years, „**We have been multiplying social capital**”.



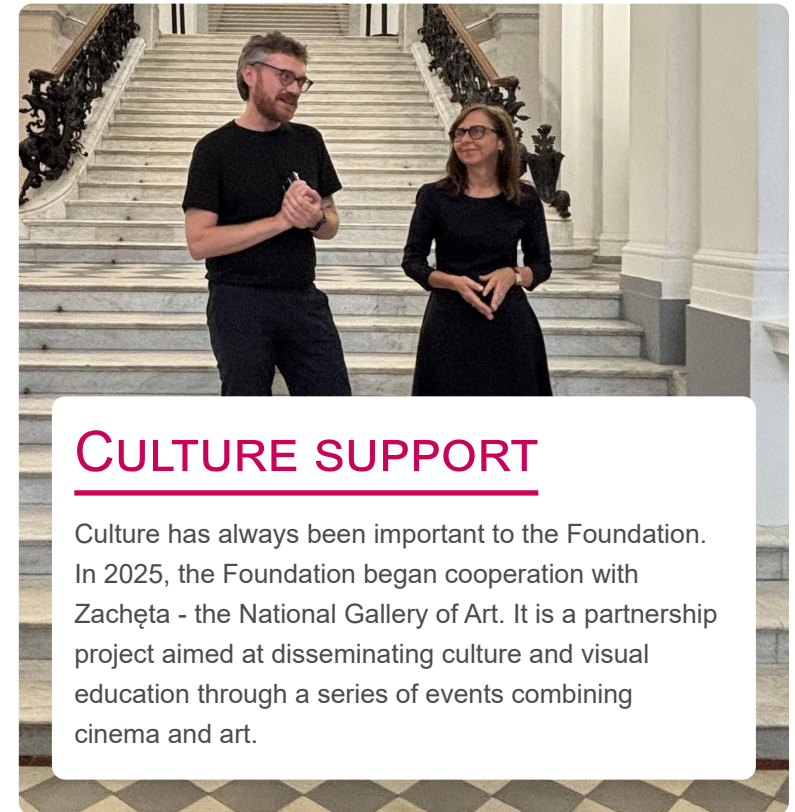
## FINANCIAL EDUCATION

# FINANCIAL ABCs

Since 2016, the Foundation has been running an educational programme „Financial ABCs” addressed to preschool children and their parents and guardians. The programme is an original initiative aimed at introducing the youngest to the world of finance in a simple, understandable and fun-filled way. It is based on workshops carried out in kindergarten and spreading economic knowledge not only among children, but also their parents, guardians and teachers. The Foundation offers a number of articles, guides for parents and educational videos.





# ABOUT THE WORKSHOP

The issues discussed at the Financial ABCs workshops in kindergartens are:

- value of money,
- expense planning,
- types of payments,
- differences between a want and a need,
- saving,
- secure payments.

The programme of the Financial ABCs workshop teaches children:

- good habits and positive social attitudes,
- making responsible decisions,
- independence,
- creative thinking,
- cooperation.

## FROM 2016 TO THE END OF 2025



In 2025, the Financial ABCs programme was under the patronage of the Ombudsman for Children.

*Financial education is a very important area of the Foundation's activity. The Financial ABCs Programme has been implemented continuously since 2016. We decided to train preschoolers because we believe that good habits, including financial ones, are worth shaping from an early age. During the workshops, we want to arouse curiosity, promote entrepreneurship and create positive social attitudes. We have trained almost 100 thousand children by visiting kindergartens throughout Poland. In 2025, we started working on adapting the entire programme so that financial education is available to all children, regardless of their abilities or limitations.*





## EDUCATIONAL MATERIALS FOR CHILDREN AND PARENTS

The Financial ABCs are not only a programme based on workshops in kindergartens. As part of the programme, the Bank Millennium Foundation provides educational materials for children and their parents and guardians on its social channels and website.

**Fairy Tales with Mr. Sebastian** is a children's guide to the world of finance. In animated videos available on YouTube, it teaches among others:

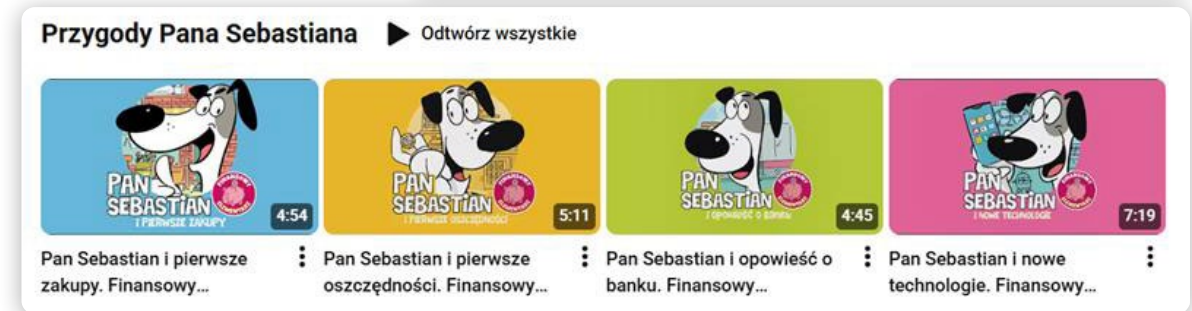
- how the bank works,

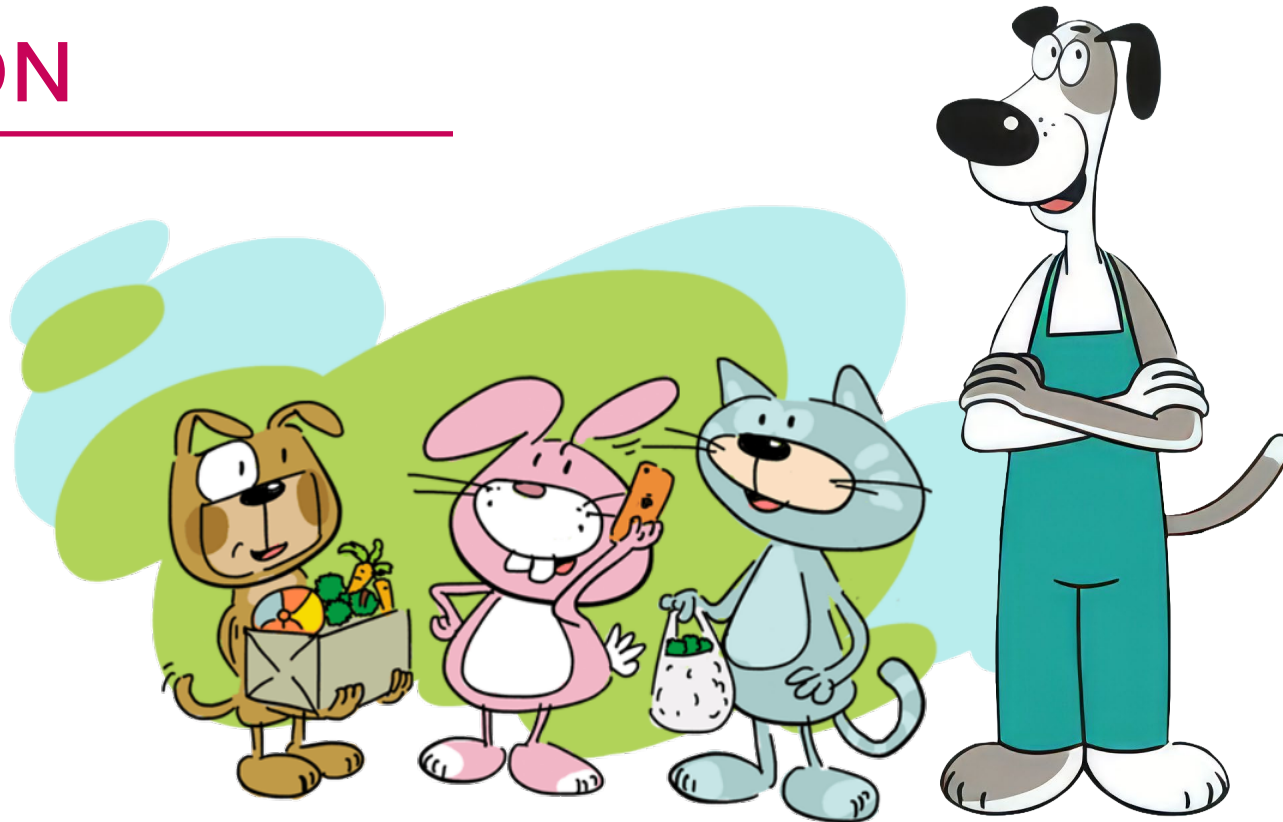


# ON THE NEED FOR ACCESSIBILITY OF FINANCIAL EDUCATION

The Bank Millennium Foundation sees great value in providing equal access to financial education for all children – regardless of their needs and abilities. Therefore, in 2025, measures have been taken towards the full availability of the Financial ABCs programme.

## Why is it important?

Children with disabilities – hearing, vision, intellectual or motor disabilities – often have limited access to standard educational materials. Meanwhile, financial education from an early age is crucial for their future independence and understanding of the world of money. **The Bank Millennium Foundation emphasizes that every child has the right to knowledge that will help them make informed decisions in adult life.**



In 2025, the Foundation translated video materials into sign language – this is the first step towards making the programme fully accessible. As part of the 15th edition of the Financial ABC 11 workshops were conducted in therapeutic and specialist facilities for over 100 children with different needs and abilities.



# PARTICIPATION IN THE CONGRESS OF ECONOMIC EDUCATION

The Bank Millennium Foundation presented its experience in financial education of the youngest, including the development of the programme and its adaptation to the needs of children with disabilities. This event highlighted the Foundation's role in shaping financial awareness in Poland, as well as the need for accessibility of education for people with disabilities.

## Interview in the „Bank” magazine

The Chairwoman of the Foundation, Iwona Jarzębska, gave an extensive interview on the accessibility of financial education and the Foundation's activities for the inclusion of children with disabilities. The conversation emphasized the importance of equal access to knowledge and innovative solutions in education.

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Foundation co-organized a unique event for employees' families – full of educational attractions and games inspired by the Financial ABCs programme. It was an opportunity to integrate and celebrate family values together.

# DIVERSITY OF VOLUNTEERING

In 2025, the Bank Millennium Foundation's volunteering gained a completely new formula – instead of thematic activities, as in previous years, it opened up to a variety of projects responding to local needs.

## Areas of volunteer activity in 2025:



### Children and youth

Educational workshops, actions for children with disabilities, help in children's homes.



### Older people

Outdoor cinema, creative workshops. Projects supporting activation and building social ties.



### People in need

Support for the sick in hospices, help in hospitals, homes of single mothers. Activities of a care and assistance nature.



### Environment

Cleaning green areas, planting trees, environmental education. Pro-ecological and educational campaigns that engage the community.



### Animals

Collections of food and toys, help in shelters. Support for pro-animal organizations and improvement of conditions in shelters.



# STORIES OF BANK MILLENNIUM FOUNDATION VOLUNTEERS

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## JOANNA

As part of the volunteer campaign, I coordinated three different projects. One of the projects was help in the hospice. While doing gardening work, we knew that these are not just plants and paths – it is a space where patients and their loved ones are looking for peace, breath and moments of solace. Every flower planted, every tidy place was like a silent gesture of support for people going through the most difficult moments of their lives. This part of volunteering reminded us how fragile and at the same time extremely precious life is.



## MAGDALENA

Helping gives me the feeling that I am doing something necessary and good at the same time. I see that my presence really helps someone, even if it's small gestures. I feel enormous empathy and gratitude. Contact with other people or animals teaches me patience and mindfulness. I do it because sometimes it's enough just to be there for someone when they really need it.



## IZABELA

Volunteering gives great emotion and a sense of really deep meaning. It's amazing how small gestures can change world – and by helping, we're actually saving a part of ourselves. Volunteering teaches that true strength lies in kindness, and any help, even the smallest, can be the beginning of a better tomorrow.

Volunteering gives me space to grow in areas that are important to me; social responsibility and ecology. In addition, it is a chance to meet great people and do good together. For the second year in a row, we have been auctioning honey from the Wrocław beekeeping at the Charity Auction and the Christmas Fair, we also shared it with our employees, and just before Christmas we donated it to the Children's Hospice „Formula of Good”.



# STORIES OF BANK MILLENNIUM FOUNDATION VOLUNTEERS

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## ALEKSANDRA

Volunteering reminds me of why we really work with people. That behind every story, need or problem there is a specific person — with emotions, hope and a moment when someone just doesn't want to be alone. It gives me the courage to act, even when I don't have ready-made solutions. It teaches mindfulness, responsibility and the fact that sometimes the most important thing we can give is presence and consistency in action. Volunteering makes me stronger. It shows that meaning is born where empathy meets community, and individuals decide to do something together — for others. And this is the value that I take with me every day. To work. To my relationships. To life.



## KAROLINA

The implementation of volunteer projects allowed to shed light on the problem of rejection experienced by loved ones and society. The first project focused on providing material and financial support to the residents of the Boys' Home in Broniszewice — boys of different ages and varying degrees of disability, who had already lost their homes and families once, for various reasons. The second project concerned the support of the Daj Herbatę foundation, which operates locally in Warsaw, for people in the homelessness crisis, people who, unfortunately, still face family and social ostracism.

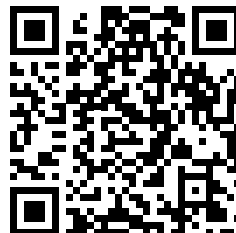
